Sheriff Lamphere came before the Commissioners to address the items on the agenda pertaining to his department.

Sheriff Lamphere along with Commissioner Walton whom is a Compact Butte County Board Member Representative submitted a letter to the Pennington County Commissioners encouraging them to consider adding additional Full Time Employees at the Juvenile Services Center. Both Sheriff Lamphere and Commissioner Walton feel the addition of extra FTE's will be a benefit to the Federal Bureau of Prisons and the US Marshals and may help to reduce local costs to operate and maintain the Juvenile Services Center for the Compact Members.

Sheriff Lamphere also discussed the Firearms Upgrade that is required every five years. Motion by Geis Second by Richards to authorize Sheriff Lamphere to purchase new firearms and trade in his department's old firearms. The cost to the county will be \$1,314.00 Vote Unanimous. Motion Carried.

The week of May 16, 2016 is Recognition of Law Enforcement week. Sheriff Lamphere purchased Range Gear Bags to give to Chief Deputy Gary Brunner, Deputy Tristin Clements, Deputy Miles Burhenn and Deputy Marlyn Pomrenke.

Interim State's Attorney Cassie Wendt came before the Commissioners to discuss the items on the agenda pertaining to her department. No action was taken.
